All Education majors at Morgan State University, meeting the following criteria are encouraged to apply for the Sylvia Avery Memorial Scholarship.

Submission and preferred eligibility requirements for applicants are as follows:

1. The applicant must be in good academic standing with Morgan State University;
2. The applicant must complete a 1000 word essay (12-point Times New Roman) addressing:
 - *"The Advantages/Benefits of Becoming an Educator"*
 - *"Why education is Important to me"*
 - *"How I plan to use my education to impact others"*
3. The applicant must be currently enrolled at Morgan State University and have completed the previous semester at the University.
4. The applicant must have officially declared Education as his or her major (proof must be provided).
5. The applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from educational professionals at Morgan State University who can attest to the applicant's character and desire to become an Educator. One of the letters of recommendation must be from an Academic Advisor or a current or past professor of the applicant.
